



## AEROMEXICO WILL LAND FOR THE FIRST TIME IN CARTAGENA, COLOMBIA

- It will be a daily flight from Mexico City starting February 20, 2025, just in time for Carnival.
- This is the airline's third destination in Colombia, in addition to Bogota and Medellin.
- With this new route, there will be 70 weekly flights connecting both countries.

**Mexico City, September 02, 2024.** Aeromexico will launch its third route in Colombia by adding a daily direct flight connecting Mexico City International Airport (AICM) and Rafael Nunez International Airport in Cartagena. The service will begin on February 20, 2025, before the start of the Cartagena Carnival.

Aeromexico has been flying to Colombia for 14 years since it inaugurated its route to Bogota and later to Medellin. With this new market, the airline will operate 70 weekly flights to Colombia between arrivals and departures, which represents an increase of 25%, and a weekly offer of 11,600 seats.

Cartagena is one of the most visited tourist destinations in Colombia, so the new route will provide an exciting new option for customers. The city was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1984 and offers more than 20 beaches to enjoy, as well as a wide variety of artistic and cultural events.

The route will be served with Boeing 737 MAX aircrafts with a capacity for 166 passengers: 16 in Premier Class, 18 in AM Plus, and 132 in Main Cabin. This type of aircraft, ideal for short and medium-haul flights, offers a fully customized cabin with greater distance between seats, 10-inch touch screens in Main Cabin and 13 in Premier, overhead compartments that allow up to 50% more luggage storage, and high-speed Wi-Fi service, among other benefits. Tickets will be available for sale once government approval is received.

On its 90th anniversary, Aeromexico continues as Mexico's airline with the broadest network, operating around 110 domestic and international routes, connecting three continents and 21 countries.
