

AEROMEXICO EXPANDS ITS CONNECTIVITY TO THE CARIBBEAN WITH NEW ROUTES TO JAMAICA AND THE BAHAMAS

- Starting March 2027 the airline will launch two new nonstop services to Nassau and Montego Bay from Mexico City.
- Aeromexico will become the first airline to directly connect Mexico City with both destinations in the Caribbean.

Mexico City, September 21, 2026.- Aeromexico today announced the launch of two new nonstop services from Mexico City International Airport to Nassau, The Bahamas and Montego Bay, Jamaica starting in time for the 2027 Easter holiday period.

These routes mark an important milestone for Aeromexico, making it the first airline to offer scheduled service from Mexico to The Bahamas and Jamaica. The new services will further strengthen Aeromexico's Caribbean leisure network, providing passengers with convenient connectivity to two of the region's most sought-after beach destinations.

Service to Montego Bay will begin on March, 18, 2027, followed by Nassau on March, 19, 2027. Both routes will operate three times weekly. The itinerary details are as follows:

Giancarlo Mulinelli, Senior Vice President of Global Sales at Aeromexico said: *"The addition of The Bahamas and Jamaica to our Caribbean network reflects our commitment to offering customers more world-class leisure destinations. These new routes will give our passengers direct access to an extraordinary blend of tourism, gastronomy and cultural experiences, while we strengthen our connectivity from Mexico City."*

Both services, subject to government approvals, will be operated with 737 MAX 8 aircraft, featuring 166 seats. Customers will enjoy an in-flight entertainment system with personal screens at every seat, bar and snacks service, as well as seamless connections to Aeromexico's extensive domestic network with more than 40 destinations.

The addition of Nassau and Montego Bay joins the airline's existing Caribbean services to Punta Cana and Santo Domingo in the Dominican Republic, as well as Havana, Cuba. For the Easter season 2027, the company will offer more than 4,000 weekly seats to the Caribbean, across 27 weekly frequencies.

From the crystal-clear waters of The Bahamas to Jamaica's vibrant culture, music, and world-famous beaches, both destinations offer unforgettable experiences for travelers seeking a relaxing beach escape or outdoor adventures.
